	Step of the TH	Evidence for Macbeth
1	Of high estate/nobility/prestige	
2	A tragic flaw in character	
3	Intrusion of time, sense or urgency	
4	Misreading/Rationalization by the TH	
5	Murder, exile, alienation of enemies and allies	
6	Gradual isolation of Tragic Hero (from others or by own self)	
7	Mobilization of those opposed to the TH	
8	Recognition of tragic flaw, but too late	

9	Last courageous attempt to restore greatness.	
10	Audience recognizes potential for greatness.	
11	Death/destruction of TH	
12	Restoration of order to the world
